



Peoria Notre Dame High School Randy Simmons Tuition Assistance Scholarship

Peoria Notre Dame High School and the Simmons family announce the **Randy Simmons Tuition Assistance Scholarship**. The award will be given to one 8th grade student for use each year, freshman-senior years, while attending Peoria Notre Dame High School.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND PRIORITIES

The Randy Simmons Tuition Assistance Scholarship, an endowed scholarship at Peoria Notre Dame High School, was established by Patti Simmons, in memory of her husband, Randy Simmons (April 16, 1957-February 19, 2019) who was Principal of Peoria Notre Dame High School (2014-2019). The scholarship was established with a sincere desire to encourage and support families whose student otherwise may not be able to attend Peoria Notre Dame High School.

The Randy Simmons Tuition Assistance Scholarship will be awarded annually to an incoming freshman meeting the established criteria. The recipient will receive the scholarship annually for their four years at Peoria Notre Dame High School. The scholarship is administered by the Advancement Director of Peoria Notre Dame as part of the overall scholarship program. Selection of a recipient will be determined by the members of PND faculty and staff and the Simmons family.

No later than **December 10, 2021** (postmarked or dropped off to the Peoria Notre Dame office by this date) the following must be submitted to the program administrator (Advancement Director):

- 1) The Randy Simmons Tuition Assistance Application, including an essay.
- 2) A letter of recommendation from a teacher or coach/club advisor.
- 3) The application process includes the completion of the FACTS Grant and Aid application located at <https://online.factsmgmt.com/signin/42H9P>. Results will be used for consideration of the recipient.
- 4) Report cards from 7th grade and up-to-date 8th grade



CRITERIA AND DETAILS

Recipients shall be practicing Catholics, as verified by their pastor. Criteria may involve such things as grades, class participation, behavior in class and participation in extracurricular activities. These criteria must be maintained throughout the four years of the award while meeting the standards of the institution. The funds awarded may only be applied to tuition at Peoria Notre Dame High School. Once a student at Peoria Notre Dame, the student must maintain a 2.5 GPA and participate annually in the community by serving more than 20 hours in volunteer service, be involved in an activity/sport or have a part-time job.

- FACTS Grant & Aid application completed
- application including signatures
- essay on separate piece of paper
- letter of recommendation
- report cards from grades 7 and 8 (as current as possible for 8th grade)
