ACADEMIC OVERVIEW

- Rigorous trimester system uniquely prepares students for college
- Accelerated academic solid courses are completed in two trimesters allowing students the opportunity to explore additional course options beyond traditional graduation requirements
- Differentiated College preparatory instructional levels are available including modified, regular, and honors
- GPA is calculated on a 4.0 weighted scale
- Students are ranked by their GPA; exact ranks and GPA are provided to colleges on all student transcripts
- 50 Honors courses available
- Foreign language options include Latin, Spanish,
 French, and German

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

- 23 Advanced Placement (AP) courses
- 27 additional Honors courses prepare students for AP testing, but without official AP designation
- 8 Dual Credit and 4 Early College online options are available through partnership with Illinois Central College
- 80% of students who took AP exams in the spring of 2022 scored a 3 or greater


