

#### **SEMESTERS**

- •Seven classes per semester
- •Continuous instruction in STEAM and world language courses
- •Alignment with ICC courses for dual credit and early college
- •18 weeks in a semester

#### WINTERIM

- •Two-week session of engaging and hands-on courses (8-11 am, 12-3 pm) between semesters
- •Opportunity for elective, recovery, and/or PE credit, senior internships, and service projects

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
